Year 3 Trip to Africa Alive

We will be taking all the children in year 3 on a school trip to Africa Alive for part of our topic on Skeletons and classifying animals on 28th April 2020.

The children should wear normal school uniform and sensible footwear. They should bring a sunhat or a raincoat, dependant on the weather forecast. They will also require a packed lunch, snack and plenty of water to drink.

A school packed lunch is available to order via Parent Pay in the usual way. For those children who are in receipt of free school meals, please also place the order in this way, but no payment will be required. Orders will need to be placed on or before 1st April 2020.

We require a contribution of £14.55; those children eligible for Pupil premium funding (this includes all children who are entitled to free school meals) are able to take part at the reduced contribution of £9.75. This is voluntary but if we do not receive adequate payment, the trip may be cancelled and not go ahead. These payments must be made via ParentMail/PlusPay.

Payment and consent to be made by parentmail by the 24th April 2020.

If your child requires any prescribed medication during the trip, please contact the school for a medical form.
