Dear Parents/Carers,

Firstly, thank you for confirming your child's attendance on our year group's residential visit to the Horstead Centre in May. We are now in a position to confirm a few more details and provide some further information on the visit.

As previously advised, two classes from our year group will be going at one time over a period of three days and two nights. These have been selected based on the number of children attending from each class to ensure that our numbers are spread as evenly as possible over the week. They will be as follows:

A reminder that we are asking you to provide £80. Those children eligible for Pupil Premium funding (this includes all children who are entitled to free school meals) are able to take part at the reduced contribution of £40. Should you have any questions regarding this, please contact the school office. You will have now paid at least the £10 deposit. **The remainder should be paid by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> April.** However, as always, if this could be a problem, please let us know.

In the meantime, please see the attached medical forms. The medical forms are a safety requirement imposed on us and must be completed before any child can attend the residential. Therefore, please could these be returned to school as soon as possible.

Also provided is a recommended kit list, this should help to give you an idea of the items the children should and should not bring with them. Please note in particular the need for the children to bring both **a sleeping bag and a pillow case** with them.
