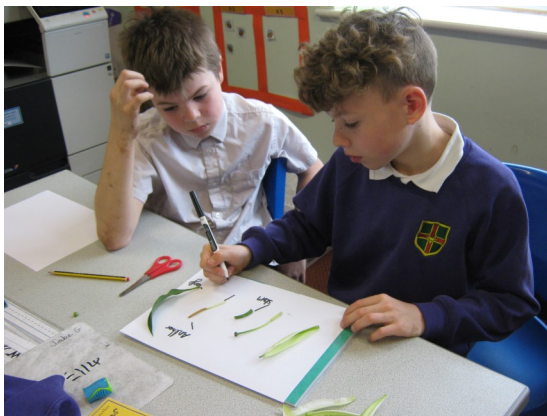


Science Family Café
