Dear Parents/Carers,

In year 6, your child will be expected to carry out weekly homework tasks. Generally, homework will be set on a Friday and due the following Wednesday which should give everyone a good chance to have a go at it over the weekend and then if required gain any additional help with it that they may need at the start of the following week.

At a reasonable cost to the school we have purchased Maths, Reading and Grammar practice questions for all year 6 pupils. We have found these a very good resource in the past as the children work towards their SATs exams later in the academic year.

Furthermore, it has been supportive in respect of the children learning how to organise and prioritise their time, meeting a deadline and a good step towards the much greater amount of homework they will receive once they are at High School.

Although some children may be keen to race ahead and complete additional tasks, please can I ask that children only do the activities set for the week as where possible we have tried to make links to what we will be learning at the time in school. This should avoid the confusion of anyone attempting something that they have not learnt much about yet!

Should your child need any help with their homework there will be:

- Class teachers will be available to support on Monday or Tuesdays
- For any uncompleted homework there will be a further available homework club within Year 6 to ensure tasks can be completed ahead of going through and learning from them on a Wednesday afternoon in class.
