Thank you for all your donations.



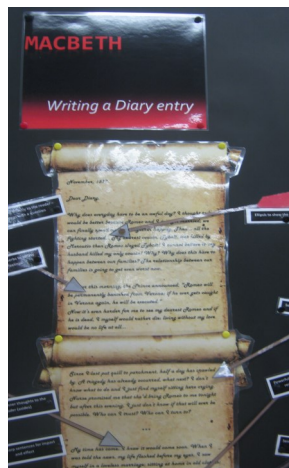
All Hail Macbeth!

- ◆ Use a range of drawing and sketching techniques to produce a portrait of one of the characters.

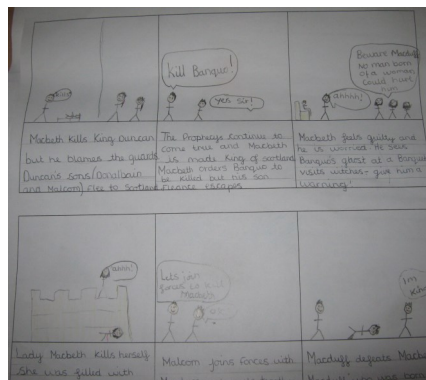
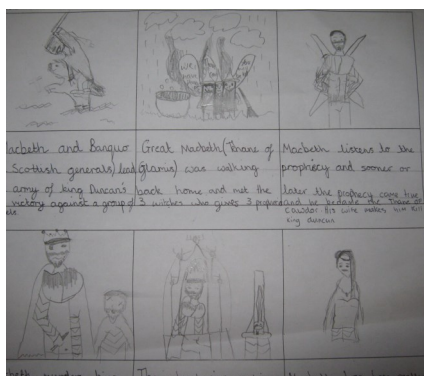
