Population- Number of people who live in a place.

Physical feature- Something which occurs naturally in a place e.g river, mountain etc

Human feature- Something which humans have put there e.g. city, farm, building etc

Prime meridian- Imaginary line that splits the Earth into 2 equal parts vertically and is the basis for time zones.

Civilisation- A place where people live as a community.

Dynasty- A place ruled by kings from the same family.

Century- 100 years

Pagoda- Tower with many layers.

KEY FACTS

- China is the 3rd largest country in the world and has the largest population.
- It is found in the northern hemisphere in the east of Asia and is bordered by 14 countries.
- It is made up of mountains, desert, large cities with tall skyscrapers and plains (flat lands).
- The climate varies depending on what part of China it is.
- China is home to many historical sites as some of the earliest civilisations started there.
- The Shang dynasty is the earliest civilisation evidence has been found for.
- The Shang dynasty started about 1600BC when Cheng Tang won the battle with the Xia king. It lasted for 5 centuries and power was handed down brother to brother. The last king was cruel so he was overthrown.
