### **Made in China**

Look at labels on things in your home – food, clothing, electronic items and plastics to see what was made in China. Make a chart or draw pictures of each item.

### **Collect data**

Choose 4 or 5 modern Chinese dishes and use a tally chart to find out which is the most popular! Present your results using a pictogram or bar graph.

### **Chinese New Year**

Draw your Chinese New Year birth year animal and label the key characteristics.

### **China Facts**

Research China (historical, geographical or cultural facts) and present your findings in any way you choose e.g. poster, fact file.

### **Chinese myths**

Go to the library and read some Chinese myths then illustrate and summarise them for your class mates. You could even write your own.

### **Willow patterns**

Have a go at drawing more willow patterns but use a different media (not ink, maybe paint, crayon, felt tip).

### **Is it magnetic?**

Create a chart showing things that are magnetic and things that are not magnetic in your home.

### **Push or pull?**

Look around your home or local environment (park, playground, sports field/centre, car) to find things that you push or pull to move.

Draw a chart showing things you move by pushing and things you move by pulling.
