Travel to events is included which is supportive. Better impact would have been seen if more events had have been attended – staffing issues negatively impacted on this. If to continue next year, maximise event attendance.
Autumn 2018	Purchase of a MUGA (Multi	£30,931	Wider range of physical activities available to children at break and lunch time as well as in lessons when the weather is poorer. MUGA is well used by the school and there is clear increased physical activity during these times. Funding topped up through school funds
Spring 2019	PE Equipment	£500	Additional balls and equipment for outdoor and indoor PE meant better access to the curriculum through a wider range of resources available to the children.
