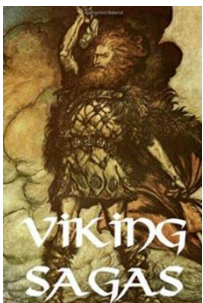

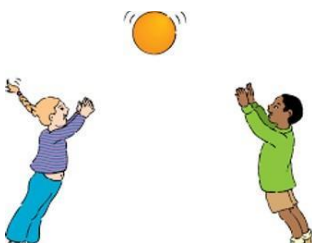
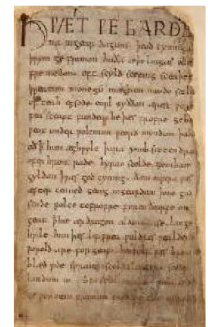
Our topic will kick off with an historical enquiry where the children will become history detectives by asking questions and using
