



## Covid-19 – Alerting the school over the Christmas break

Dear Parents and Carers,

Please see the information below on how and when to report a confirmed Covid case of a pupil at the school.

Date symptoms began (or test date if asymptomatic)	Between Monday 14 <sup>th</sup> — Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> December	Saturday 19 <sup>th</sup> December	Sunday 20 <sup>th</sup> December	Monday 21 <sup>st</sup> December – Monday 4 <sup>th</sup> January
Action Required	Parents inform school immediately via MyEd messaging app or the school office directly  School will notify individuals within respective bubble who may have come into close contact.  Close contacts will have to self-isolate for 10 days from the day after the person tested positive (in line with new DfE guidance 14.12.20)	Parents Inform school immediately. Go to the website homepage www.derehamjunior.dneat.org You will see the top tab is marked Covid Reporting. Please complete the form you are taken to.  School will notify individuals within respective bubble who may have come into contact on Thursday 17 <sup>th</sup> and Friday 18 <sup>th</sup> December.  Close contacts will have to self-isolate for 10 days from the day after the person tested positive (new guidance DfE 14.12.20)	Parents Inform school immediately. Go to the website homepage www.derehamjunior.dneat.org You will see the top tab is marked Covid Reporting. Please complete the form you are taken to.  School will notify individuals within respective bubble who may have come into contact on Friday 18th December.  Close contacts will have to selfisolate for 10 days from the day after the person tested positive (new guidance DfE 14.12.20)	Unless testing was delayed following onset of symptoms, case was not in setting and therefore there is no need to contact school.

In order to ensure these arrangements work effectively and minimise the risk of compromising families' Christmas break, please adhere to the following:

- Parents to seek tests via testing centres rather than via postal tests as this can significantly delay confirmation of results. Results are normally received in 24hours via test centres.
- Parents notify the school if children have symptoms after school closes (as outlined above) even when waiting for test results.
- Parents to notify close contact family and friends and follow advice as per NHS Covid-19 guidelines http://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/

If your child is not well enough to return to school after the Christmas break, please return to using the usual absence reporting systems.
