## Midday Supervisory Assistant

## Responsible to: School Business Manager and Headteacher

5.5 hours per week, for 38 weeks per year, term time only plus mandatory training such as Safeguarding and First Aid.

Salary: Support Salary Grade A, Point 1 pro rata (£9.25 / hour)

- Supervision of children in all areas of the school, including, dining room, play areas and classrooms - as directed by either School Business Manager, Headteacher or Deputy Headteacher, in order to ensure the safety, well-being and good behaviour of the children at all times.
- 2. Supervision of the children during the meal to ensure a good atmosphere is maintained. Ensuring good eating habits and helping children where necessary.
- 3. The maintenance of good order at all times to ensure school standards are adhered with.
- 4. Ensure excellent hygiene and encourage regular hand washing, including before and after eating
- 5. General assistance in the dining area as necessary, e.g. wiping up spillages to ensure a safe and ordered environment is maintained at all times and cleaning all surfaces after lunch
- 6. Supervision of children to and from the dining room to ensure good order is maintained at all times, (at present, all children are eating in their classrooms due to Covid).
- 7. Set up and clear away tables in the dining room (when using the main hall).
- 8. To provide, if needed, emergency care and administer first aid.
