


## **Key Info**

As part of our efforts to help the children catch up on some of their missed work we have altered our curriculum to include more work on the fundamentals of maths especially place value as well as the four operations. Over the next three weeks we will be looking at fractions. We covered what the children missed in Year 2 before Easter and we are now moving on to Year 3 fraction work. The children are using Bar models to show how to find a fraction of an amount.
