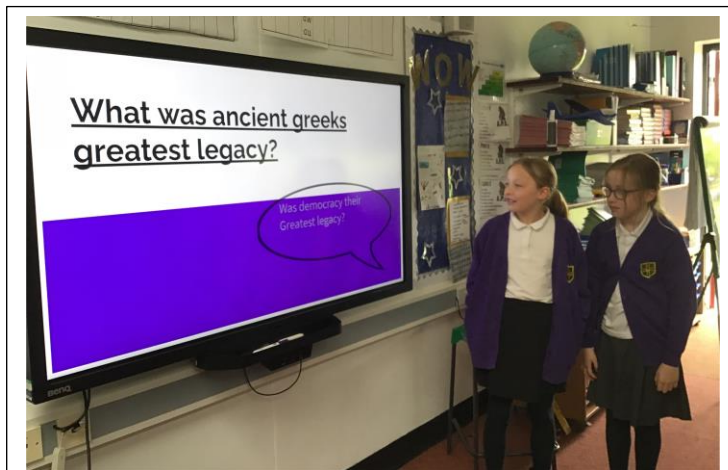
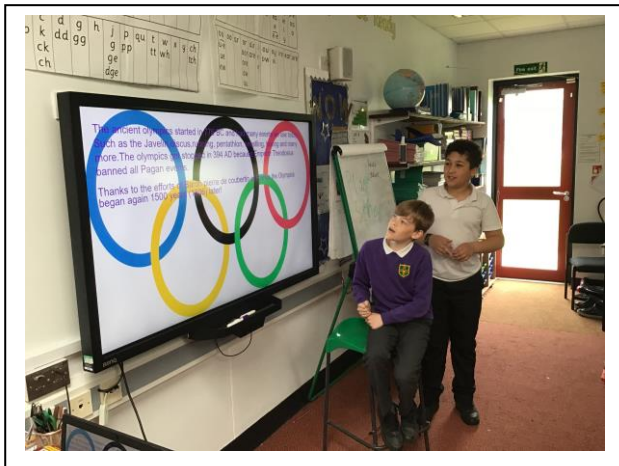




# Year 5
