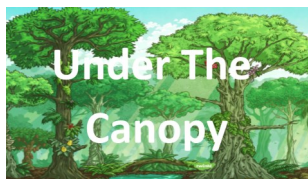
High School Applications

'Under The Canopy'

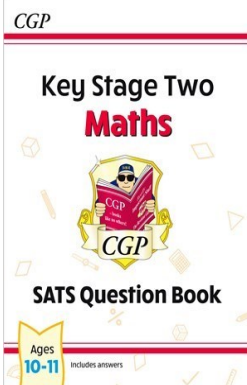
The children have been super busy in their Topic lessons. Highlights have included:

Important Information

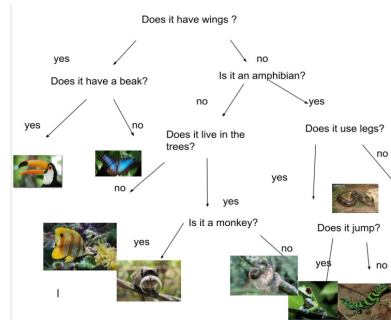

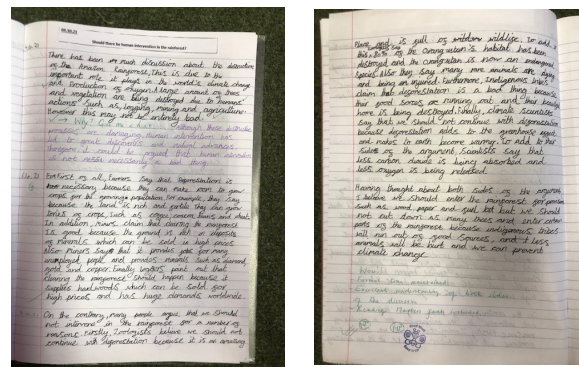
