Soon, we will be debating about whether people should interfere with the rainforest.

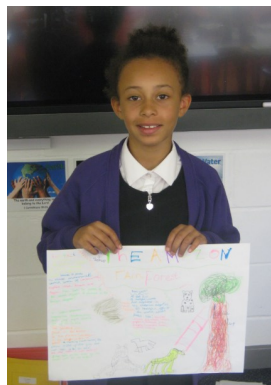
How can it be October next week?!
