Marvellous Maths!

After spending most of the half term looking at place value, all four classes have now moved on to looking at written methods for addition and subtraction. We have looked at using expanded and compact column addition and column subtraction and will soon be moving on to looking at solving addition and subtraction word problems as well as looking at how we can use rounding alongside these to estimate.
