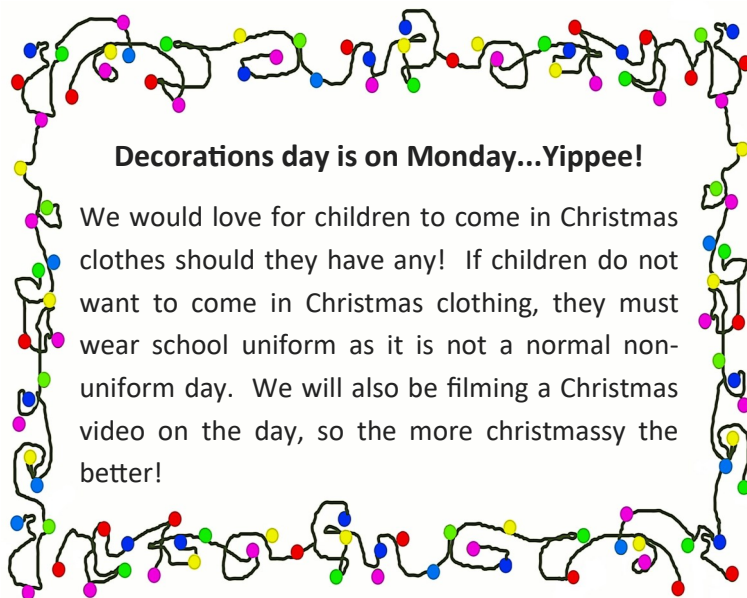
Outside Play
