What have we been up to?

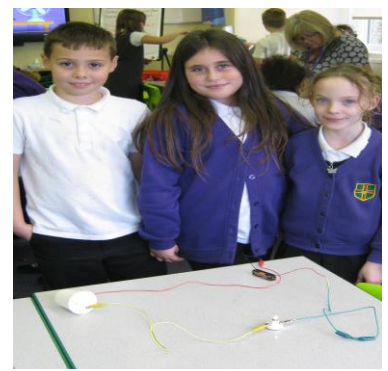
Treasure Island
