We have lots of fun things to look forward to such as our Residential at Norfolk Lakes, a trip to the beach, a rounder's tournament and Sports Day all to come.

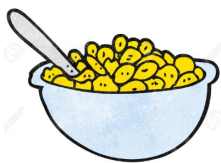
So Year 6, rest up, come to Breakfast Club, try not to worry and just do your best! Roll on a long and warm Summer.

The Y6 Residential is really not far away now. We will be heading off to Norfolk Lakes on the first day of the last half term.

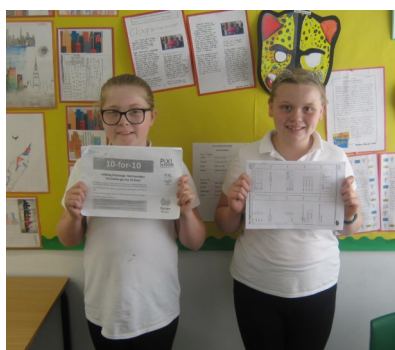
Please continue with payments and return those important medical and consent forms as soon as you can.
