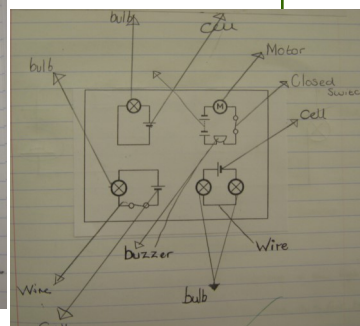
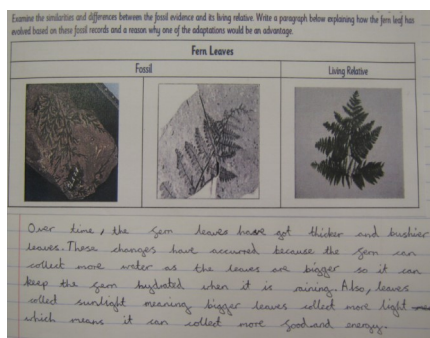
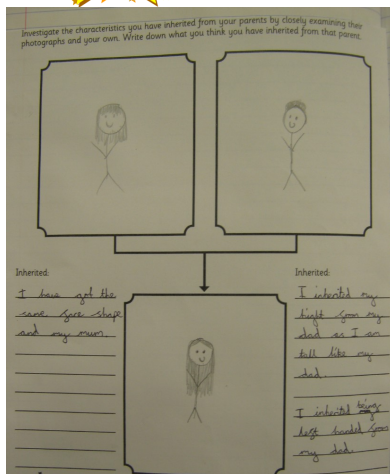


WOW Work!
