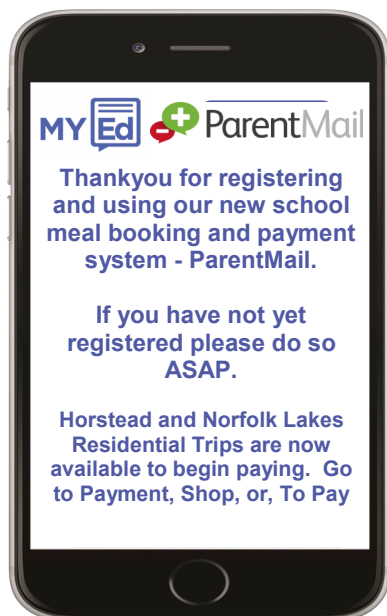
Some children seem to be coming into school in purple polo shirts. These shirts were made by mistake and should not be in circulation. School uniform is a white polo shirt.
