The children must wear their school polo shirt and sweatshirt/cardigan but can wear suitable trousers/jeans/leggings plus comfortable, appropriate footwear. We want them to be comfortable as they will be exploring, sliding, climbing and generally being physical whilst there.

They should bring a sunhat or a raincoat, dependant on the weather forecast. They will also require a packed lunch, snack and plenty of water to drink.

We require a contribution of £10.80 per child towards the cost of the trip. For those entitled to Pupil Premium funding (which includes all children entitled to Free School Meals) the cost will be £7.20 and is payable on PlusPay (ParentMail) **by Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March**. This is voluntary but if adequate payment is not received the trip may not go ahead.

Your consent for your child to participate will also be required. We are pleased to let you know this can now be given on PlusPay (ParentMail). If you do not consent online, you will be asked to complete a paper consent form, which will be sent to you nearer the time of the trip.

A school packed lunch is available to order via PlusPay (ParentMail) in the usual way. For those children in receipt of free school meals, please also place the order in this way. No payment will be required. Orders will need to be placed **on or before Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March** (due to the Easter Holidays).

If your child requires any prescribed medication during the trip, please contact the school for a medical form.
