Let The Battle Commence! The children will:

English

- This half term, the children will read, learn about and then write their own Viking Sagas focusing on character and setting descriptions.
- They will also write some poetry to link with our Viking topic, inspired by the famous story of Beowulf.

History

- Children will learn about the where the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings came from and their struggle to coexist across the British Isles.
- We will understand where the Anglo-Saxons and Viking periods took place within British History.
- Children will learn how knowledge of the past is constructed from a range of sources and learn to by select relevant historical information.

Science

 We will be looking at how to display results linked to our topic in line graphs and how to analyse and evaluate the results we have acquired.

Physical Education

- Real PE Health and Fitness Skills (Indoor)
- Tag Rugby (Outdoor)

PSHE

The children will learn about the importance and requirements of making health lifestyle choices including the benefits of physical activity and a balanced diet.

Art & Design

- Children will study Vikinginspired patterns and designs from shields and figureheads of longships.
- They will also be designing their very own Viking Longship.

Mathematics

- We will be investigating area and perimeter of both simple and compound shapes.
- We will also be learning about fractions and then learn about their decimal and percentage equivalents.

French

 The children will learn to discuss and give their opinions about different hobbies.

Music

 Take part in weekly Ukulele sessions. (Wednesdays)

Geography

The children will learn about the key physical and human characteristics at areas settled by Anglo-Saxons and Vikings over time.

Religious Education

We will be learning towards answering the question 'Is It fair?' – Philosophy focus (Last week of Half term)
