KEY VOCABULARY

Civilisation – the ideas, customs, and social behaviour of a particular group of people in a specific place or time.

Settlement - a place, typically one which has previously been uninhabited, where people establish a community.

Chronology - the arrangement of events or dates in the order of their occurrence.

Physical Geography – Geography concerned with naturally occurring features e.g. mountains, climate, soils, rivers etc

Human Geography – The study of how humans interact with the physical geography of where they live or settle.

Sacrifice - the offering of an animal, plant, or some material possession to a deity or God.

Trade – the actions of buying and selling goods and services.

Fair trade - Fairtrade is about better prices, decent working conditions, local sustainability, and fair terms of trade for farmers and workers in the developing world.

KEY FACTS

- It is thought that Mayan civilisation began in approximately - 2000BC when hunter-gathers began to settle in Central America.
- Maya society was formed of a number of city states each with their own ruler; each city was surrounded by rural settlements.
- During this time, society became more organised around these urban areas.
- Advances were made in astronomy, maths and language, as well as architecture and agriculture. Links were made with other peoples across the continent.
- No one knows for sure why the Maya civilisation went into **decline**. Possible explanations involve the overuse and exhaustion of farming land, prolonged drought, misrule, warfare and disease.
