Brasil Topic

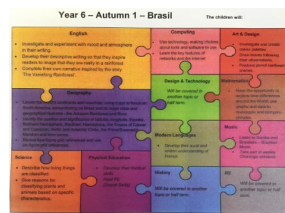
Out of the Starting Blocks

Having learnt about the Brazilian flag and the reasons behind its colours and designs we came up with and of course made them come alive with technology!



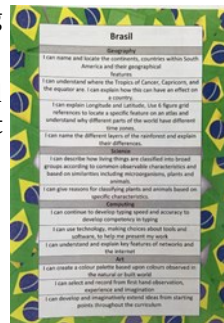
A brand new academic year and a year like we have never experienced before.
