- Find out about the Greek alphabet and present your findings in an exciting way.
- Complete a fact file for a Greek god.
- Create a picture of an imaginary Greek God. Make sure your poster is eye-catching and full of facts and information. Try to think of a symbol for your God.
- Make a Spartan helmet or design a shield.
- Write an advert persuading people to visit the ancient Olympic Games.
- Make a collage using pictures from holiday brochures or the internet showing ancient buildings and interesting place to visit in Greece.
- Who was Pythagoras? How is he linked to maths? What is Pythagoras' theory? Present your findings – use diagrams to explain what you have learnt.
- Find out some simple Greek phrases. E.g. Hello, How are you? What's your name? Etc. Can you make a poster to display them in Greek & English? Make sure you can pronounce them correctly and teach them to the class!
- Slave Diary Find out what it was like for slaves in Ancient Greece. Imagine you are a slave and write a diary entry describing your day/week.
- Complete a sketch of an Ancient Greek sculpture. What can you tell me about it?
