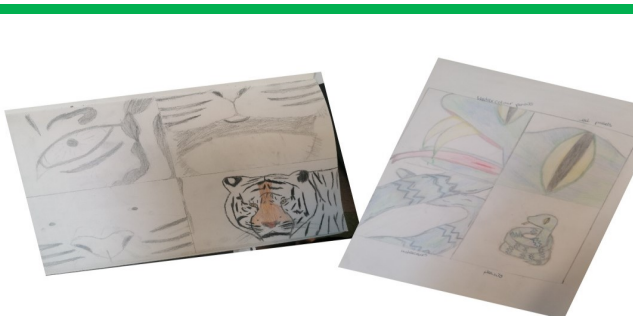
RE Week

As well as completing tests, year 6 have also been thinking about the question: ***What are the many ways in which Muslims and Christians put their faith into action?***

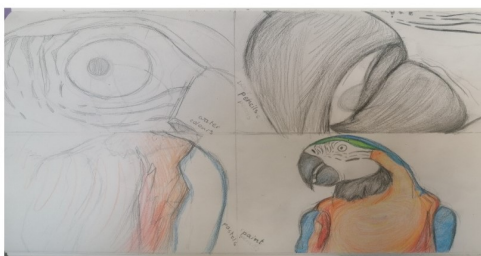

Assessments

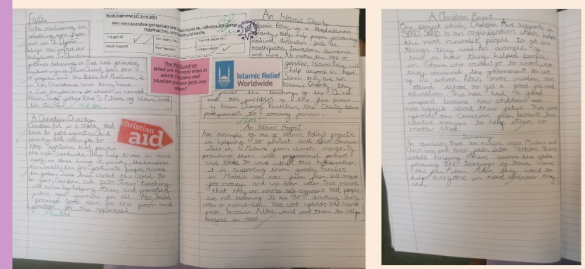

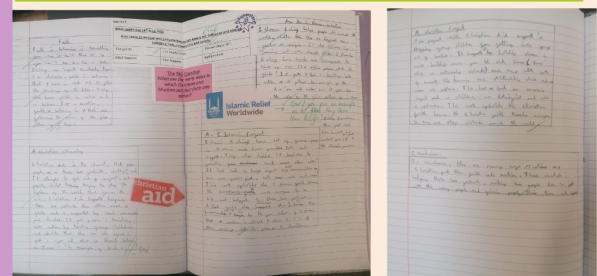
