

# STONE AGE

## History

Children will look at how people developed during the Stone Age Era.

Children will understand what a primary and secondary sources are.

Children will investigate what different primary sources say about the Stone Age people (Skara Brae, Stone Age cave paintings).

Children will understand the three key Stone Age eras- Paleolithic, Mesolithic and Neolithic as well as understand when Stone Age is in relation to other historical periods.

Children will understand the terms BC and AD.

## DT

Children will examine Stone Age tools and design a new tool that a Stone Age consumer could use.

## Art

Children will use pastels and blending to create Stone Age art in the style of cave paintings found in France and Spain.

Children will manipulate and model clay into a cave using sausages coils and pinching.

Children will identify the key features of a cave painting and create my own replica.

## Geography

Children will begin to use the terms Northern Hemisphere, Southern Hemisphere and label changes made geographically at the end of the last Ice Age.

## Computing
