Optional Stone Age Project

As Year 3 have discovered the Stone Age was an incredibly long time ago (as much as 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ million years ago in fact).

We would like the children to explore this period in history at home and present their learning in any way they choose. They may want to focus on one place e.g. Skara Brae or Stonehenge, a theme such as food or clothing or combine a range of things they have learnt about the Stone Age.

Working alongside your child to complete this task is a good way of reinforcing their learning at home and is often an enjoyable experience where you may even learn something new.

Below is a list of possible ideas that could be done but feel free to do your own thing too.

- Write a story set in the Stone Age
- Make a model of a Stone Age home
- Design clothing in the Stone Age style
- Create a quiz to ask the class back at school
- Write a fact sheet about animals during the Stone Age and illustrate it
- Design a poster full of Stone Age facts
- Make Stone Age tools
- Create a Stone Age timeline
- Write a diary for a Stone Age man or woman
- Design a comic strip set in the Stone Age

We look forward to seeing what the children produce and celebrating their efforts at the end of this half term. Please bring them to school as soon as they are ready and by no later than Friday 12th November.
