Maths!

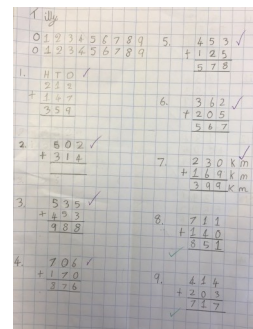
Last week we learnt about negative numbers - just in time for practicing with thermometers as the weather gets colder.
