## **Covid Updates**

We have seen a rise in staff cases this half term and we are currently very short staffed in some year groups. We are working hard to try to keep all classes open and have been able to secure some supply staff and move other staff to be able to support in order to do this. This is a challenging time for everyone and should we not have enough staff to keep a class open, we will let you know as soon as possible.

If your child is off school with Covid or awaiting a PCR test, they should be completing online learning on the google classroom. If they are too unwell to work, please let us know.

We have had to 'bubble' one class in Year 5 this week where we currently have 8 child cases and both members of staff off with Covid.

Please note – *if your child has Covid symptoms of a high temperature*, persistent cough or loss of taste or smell, they *DO STILL NEED to have a PCR test*.

If you are also choosing to test your child regularly with lateral flow tests and your child tests positive without symptoms, you do not need a follow up PCR, but MUST report the positive through to the NHS. If you could send us your confirmation from the NHS that would be very much appreciated.
