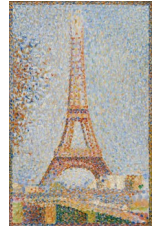




A Journey Through France

On Friday afternoon, the children will be putting all their storytelling skills to the test. Why not ask them for a performance! :)

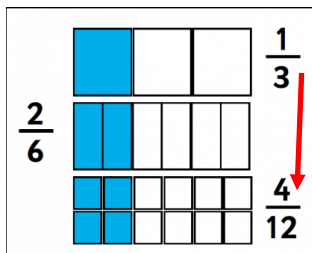

Is the number above the line and how many pieces there are.

Numerator = 3

Denominator = 4

Is the number below the line and how many equal pieces the whole is divided into.



$$1/3 + 5/12 =$$

$$4/12 + 5/12 = 9/12$$
