## Lake District Residential – 4<sup>th</sup> July – 8<sup>th</sup> July 2022

Dear parents and carers of Y6 'Lakes pupils',

We are just under two months away from our visit to the Lakes, which is very exciting! Please take the time to read this letter and respond to the accompanying information so that we are all ready and good to go when that time arrives.

### **Follow-up meeting**

Firstly, we would like to make you aware of a follow-up meeting that we will run in the school hall. This will take place on **Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> May – 6:30pm**. It is not compulsory for you to attend but we wanted to provide you with the opportunity to find out a little bit more and ask any questions you may have. During this meeting, we will also discuss the points included in the attached information.

### **Itinerary and Kit List**

The accompanying itinerary and kit list is for your reference. The itinerary is just there to remind you of timings as well as what your child will be doing when we are there.

The kit list is incredibly helpful and we wanted to get this to you in plenty of time. I cannot emphasise enough how important appropriate footwear is. There is no need for hiking boots, trainers will be fine for all activities, but your child **MUST** have an additional pair that they can use for the activity day which they won't be able to use again as they will get soaking wet. An old pair that are on the verge of being thrown out are ideal!

Please note, children will be responsible for all their own items (including pocket money) while they are on the trip. We strongly advise that they do not bring any values or family heirlooms! The children are allowed to bring pocket money, up to a maximum of £15, as there will be opportunity to buy ice creams and snacks on some of the days.

Mobile phones or any other devices that are used to 'call' each other or that can connect to the internet are **NOT ALLOWED** under any circumstances.

### **Consent/Medical Form**

In the unlikely event that your child may become ill, we must have all relevant medical information. The accompanying form has to be fully completed and returned as soon as possible. If you do not know your child's NHS Number, call your GP surgery and they will be able to give it to you. Children will not be allowed to go on the trip without a completed consent/medical form.

Lastly, a kindly reminder: the **remaining balance for the trip is due by 1.6.22**. Children will not be allowed to go on the trip if the total cost has not been paid.
