Dear Parents/Carers,

We are very excited that after half term, each of the Year 5 classes will be spending the day at the Norfolk Broads.

From Monday 13th June, we will be having a week-long topic of geographical fieldwork with a focus on the changing uses of the Norfolk Broads.

In the morning, we will take a river trip from Wroxham with a walk ashore at Hoveton Great Broad Nature Trail.

After a picnic lunch, the children will have time to sketch the local wildlife before heading back to school. We will return before the end of the school day.

The children will need to wear school uniform but are fine to wear trainers. They will require packed lunches (which are available to order from school in the usual way via ParentMail) and water bottles. Depending on the weather, they may also need sunhats and suntan lotion – or even a waterproof jacket!

To cover the cost of the coach and the excursion, we are asking for contributions of £15.48. If your child receives Free School Meals then we are asking for a contribution of £10.32.
