

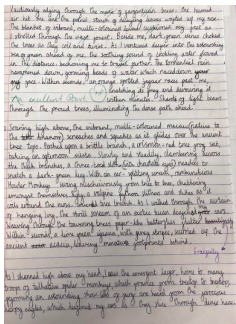


YEAR SIX
