We are incredibly excited that Year 5 will be visiting The Natural History Museum, London, on **Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March**.

Although our main aim will be to gain more knowledge about earthquakes, we will also be able to explore the 'space zone' as well as a wealth of other benefits – no doubt, the children will love the dinosaurs and the sightseeing from the coach!

To have as full a day as possible, we will be leaving school at 8am so ask that the children **arrive by 7:45 am** to be registered.

We will be leaving London at 4pm so should arrive **back to school by 7:30 pm** – traffic dependent. We will update you if the time is going to vary greatly!

The children will need a **packed lunch** (which are available to order from school in the usual way via ParentMail by Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> March), snacks and water bottles.

With fuel costs as they are, the coaches are VERY expensive, however, Mrs Scott has agreed to heavily subsidise this trip. Therefore, the cost is **£15** (or £10 to those in receipt of Free School Meals) to be be paid in the usual way along with consent via ParentMail.

Please note consent must be received for your child(ren) to be able to attend the trip.

School uniform must be worn for the day.
