## What have we been learning?

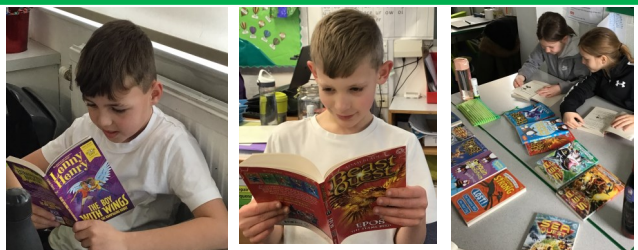
