Maths

In the last two weeks of maths, we've been learning more about rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000.

We are also looking at subtracting and adding a numbers up top four digits using a range of strategies.

English

In English, the children have been completing their own adventure narratives as well as writing their own version of the story as their Showcase piece.

We've started work on our next piece of writing. This will be a diary entry based on Boucicca's battles with the Romans. We have also been practicing writing sentences using past tense verbs.
