'Crime and Punishment' Workshop at Norwich Castle

Thursday 2nd November 2023

Dear Parents/Carers,

To help us answer our big History question '*Has our justice system always been fair and proportionate?*' - Which looks at the broad trends of crime and punishment through the ages - your child will be undertaking two workshops: '*Meet a Prisoner*' and '*Punishments from the Past*', at Norwich Castle on **Thursday 2nd November**.

During the day, we will also explore the relevant exhibits at the Museum of Norwich, which is just a short walk from the castle.

Whilst we are in Norwich, we will also take the opportunity to look at the architecture in preparation for our Art lessons in which the children will use perspective to draw skylines and famous buildings from different angles.

We will leave school shortly after registration and return in time for the end of the day. The children should come dressed in school uniform. They will require packed lunches (which are available to order from school in the usual way via ParentMail) and water bottles. By November, it is highly likely the children will also need warm coats but we will send reminders nearer the time.

In order to meet costs, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£7.02** per child or if your child receives Free School Meals, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of **£3.51** per child. Payment is to be made via ParentMail.

If you would like your child to attend the trip, **please consent via ParentMail and pay for your child by Sunday 22nd October 2023**. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the school.

Please note consent must be received for your child to be able to attend the trip.
