Homework Each Week

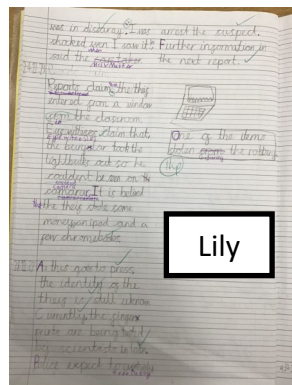
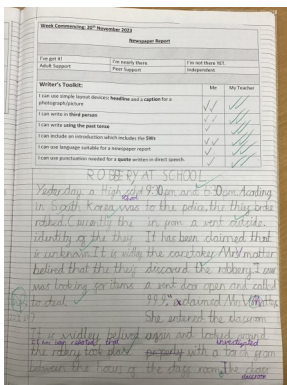
The following **must** be completed each week:
