Autumn Term 2023	Signed up to the Pay it Forward 2-Year Membership deal with West Norwich and Dereham School Sports Partnership for Academic Years 2023-24 and 2024-25	£6100	We look to maintain our fantastic relationship with the West Norwich and Dereham School Sports Partnership (WNDSSP), allowing us to take advantage of the mentoring programme; CPD and networking opportunities; access to competitions, events (both physical and virtual) and extra-curricular opportunities for our children, with travel included. (10 events have been signed up for, so far, for 2023-24).
Academic Year 2023- 24	PE Resources – replenish, replace, supplement and identify areas of both sides of the curriculum which would benefit from new resources.	£300~	Recent years have seen large investments in our PE resources but as with every year in a school of this size, overuse and mistreatment means that resources are often in need of replacing. We are also looking for opportunities to continue to support the teaching and learning of both sides of the PE curriculum and I am always looking for suggestions from teaching staff and even children of any resources which would improve their learning experiences.

Staff CPD – Coaching from two trained ICS coaches: Rob and Rhys.	£10,000~	Continuing our partnership with ICS Coaching has seen another investment in club provision for the 2023-24 academic year. Our children continue to have opportunities to join clubs during lunchtimes, after school and in the evenings throughout the week. Staff will also benefit from CPD from two ICS coaches who could support up to 6 classes every half term, providing support and opportunities for the teacher to upskill and improve their PE teaching and delivery.
