



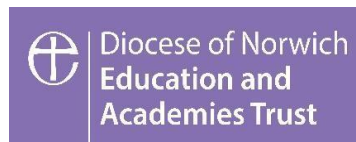

#### **End of swimming provision.**

On the day your child is going swimming, they will need to:

- Bring a swimming costume or trunks (no swim shorts)
- Bring a named bag with a towel to dry and change after
- Long hair must be tied up
- No earrings or jewellery to be worn

Also, children should wear their usual school uniform on swimming days and do not need to attend school in their P.E. kits.
