



## Art

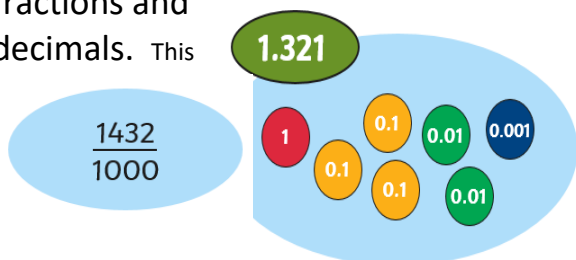
