Maths

Since half term, we have continued to explore and work with fractions. We are beginning to explore decimal equivalents to fractions.

English

In English, the children have been learning about poetry and how to write their own poems about a river. They have learned about metaphors and personification. We have used these in our poems to help create an image in the reader's mind.
