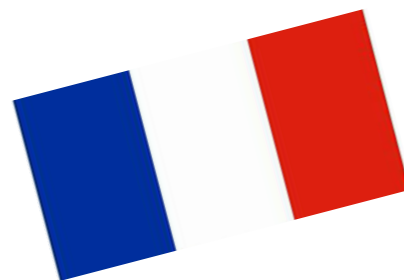




Au revoir!

A huge thank you to Wellspring Family Church for sharing their own experiences and answering so many questions!

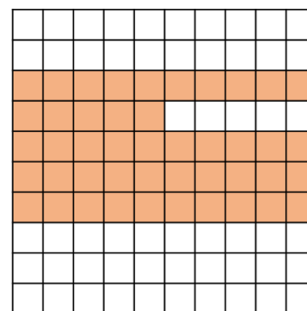
Just like you may spend time talking and communicating with friends, Christians want to spend time with God. Prayer is one way to do this. This video looks at some different reasons for talking with God.
