

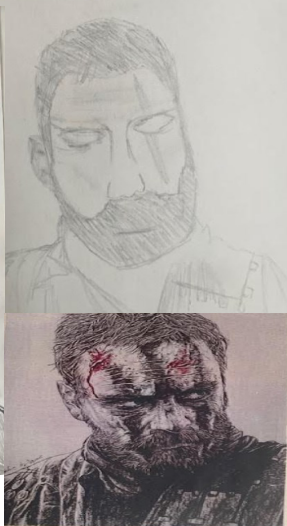
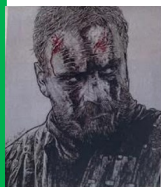

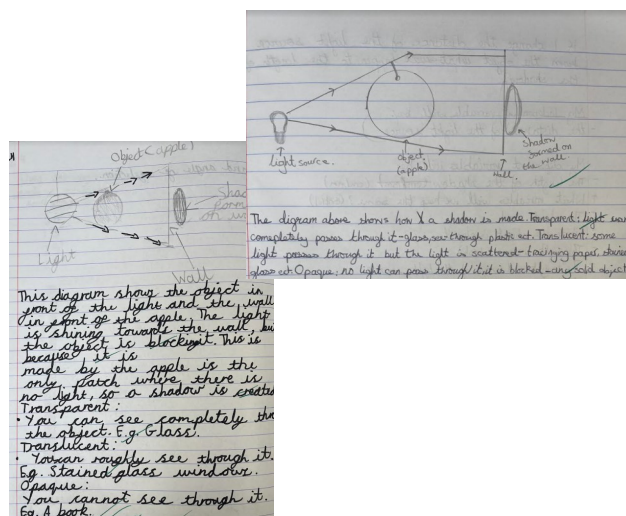
Super sketching!
