Dear Parents/Carers,

With the first week of the Horstead residential starting after the weekend, I am writing to inform you of how this will work with Malorie being split. The groups for Horstead will remain the same across the two weeks. This is the most efficient way to ensure that all children receive extracurricular activities and the week's learning that will happen while they are not at Horstead..

Week 1 (28th April -2nd May):

Horstead group 1 will attend Horstead from 28th- 30th April. Then they will carry out a sewing project in DT.

Horstead group 2 will carry out Religion & Worldviews week in school and start the sewing project.

Pupils not attending Horstead will carry out Religion & Worldviews week in school and commence the sewing project.

Children who are not attending Horstead must come to school in school uniform.

Swimming: Seacole and Malorie will still attend their swimming sessions this week. Parks will be in class together for the afternoon.

Week 2 (6th May-9th May):

Horstead group 1 will be in school carrying out Religion & Worldviews week.

Horstead group 2 will complete their sewing project and then attend Horstead from 7th – 9th May.

Pupils not attending Horstead will complete their sewing project and carry out extracurricular activities in school.

Swimming: There will be no swimming this week.

Children who are not attending Horstead must come to school in school uniform.
