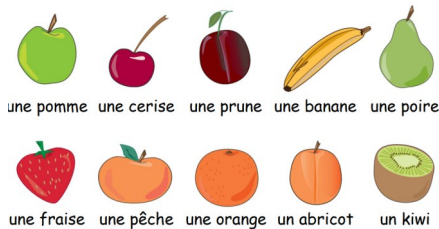

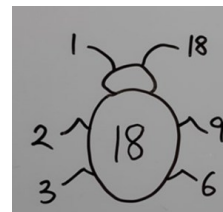
Maths

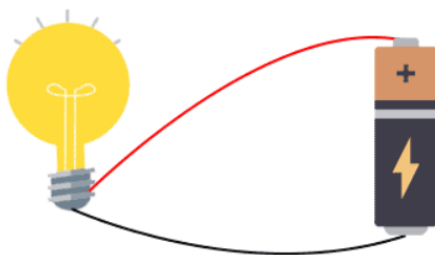
