On behalf of the FRIENDS of Dereham Junior Academy, I am delighted to let you know that we have once again secured a brilliant deal for some Leavers' Hoodies for the end of this academic year. I appreciate that we are incredibly early in writing to you about this, but it does mean we can capitalize on an excellent offer.

The Deal:

Every child will receive:

- 1 x Leavers' Hoodie with the names of every child in the year group printed on the back
- **AND** a white T-shirt with same design as the hoodie

We have decided to go for a navy hoodie with white printed logos and names, and navy print on the white t-shirts as these looked the best. There are some example images below to show you what these will look like.

Front: Logo with the school name



Back: With names from all the Year group and t-shirt with matching design.



There are five size options available:

1. 12-13 years (34")
2. Small adult (36")
3. Medium adult (40")
4. Large adult (44")
5. XLarge adult (48")



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Below is a guide for measuring your child for the Hoodie. Please note, the T-shirt will be ordered in the same size.

The hoodies and t-shirts will be available by May and distributed to the children ahead of the Residential, following their final SATS assessment. As we have in previous years, Mrs. Scott has also kindly agreed that Year Six may wear the hoodies in place of their school jumpers during their final half term with us.

These were a huge hit with the students last year.

The FRIENDS of DJA will be covering the majority of the cost, **so the cost to you will be £6 per child.**

To order, **please pay £6 via Parent Mail**, selecting the size of hoodie you wish **by no later than Friday 12th December.**

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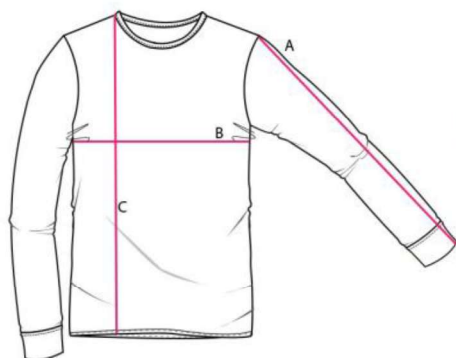


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How to measure

IMPORTANT

Please make parents aware of how to measure
for their hoodies before choosing sizes!



How to measure for hoodies

Chest	12/13 Years	S	M	L	XL
Body Length	34"	36"	40"	44"	48"
Arm Length	24"	26"	27.5"	28.5"	30"
	20"	21"	23.5"	24.5"	25"

A - Arm Length

Start at the highest point on the shoulder and measure all the way down - including cuff.
Ensure sleeve is laying flat and straight.

B - Chest

Measure 1 inch down from armhole and then straight across the chest (and multiply by 2).

C - Body Length

Start at the highest point on the shoulder (HPS) and measure straight down including hems.

**Hoodies are meant to be worn big, please order at least
one size up from your normal school uniform**
