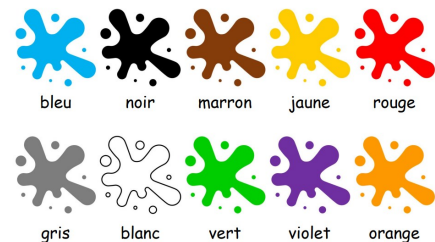
## Thank you and Merry Christmas!
